PROSPECTIVE APPROACHES TO FORMING COMMUNICATIVE COMPETENCE OF MASTER'S DEGREE STUDENTS IN NURSING

Introduction. The penetration of information technologies into all spheres of the human activities has resulted in appearance of the new social formation – the postindustrial information society. The modern requirements for development of Nursing reveal a lot of current problems including the reformation of the nurses' education. Mastering by Masters of nursing the fundamental communicative competence is considered to be of special actuality among the psychological and pedagogical aspects of multilevel education for the nurses' corps.

The **objective** of our research is the theoretical analysis of the communicative competence of the future nurses with completed higher nursing education – master's degree in nursing.

The following scientific **research methods** were applied in order to succeed in attaining the objective: mathematical modeling, content-analysis of the regulatory and legislative documents, and as well the structural analysis and logical summarizing methods.

Conclusions. Gaining the occupational and scientific competence is considered to be an integral component of the Masters in nursing education. The integral component of the Master's degree in nursing education is the educational process integration with the scientific and research work, thus enabling the forming of thereof scientific communicative competence accompanied by application of the information and telecommunication technologies.
