Граматики англійської мови є одним з найважливіших елементів вивчення мови. Вона також може бути однією з найскладніших аспектів вивчення англійської мови. Граматики є надзвичайно важлива для соціального життя. Щоб висловлюватися правильно, потрібно чітко уявляти як структурувати свої слова та правильно організувати їх в речення та текст.

Граматики англійської мови важлива для людей з різних причин, зокрема навчання за кордоном, спілкування в Інтернет просторі та повсякденних ситуаціях, робота у престижних компаніях. Хоча граматики англійської мови іноді може здатися складною, навчитися її розуміти й правильно використовувати — неймовірно корисно. Не бійтеся робити помилки, практикуючи англійську. Іноді це найкращий спосіб навчитися! Якщо ви віддані та зацікавлені у вивченні граматики, це може бути захоплюючим аспектом вивчення мови.

Рекомендації містять багато практичних прикладів та тренувальних вправ того, як і чому певна граматики використовується в повсякденній мові, тому слугує гарним помічником для швидкого засвоєння потрібної граматики.

Метою вивчення дисципліни “Практична граматики англійської мови” є зосередження на найважливіших поняттях та структурах для задоволення комунікативних потреб будь-якого мовця. Методичні матеріали до самостійної та індивідуальної роботи студентів з навчальної дисципліни “Практична граматики англійської мови” включає в себе збір якісних, вичерпних граматичних ресурсів, що допоможуть студентам опанувати ключові структури та оволодіти певними граматичними навиками та вміннями.

У результаті вивчення навчальної дисципліни студент повинен

знати: граматичні закономірності англійської мови, у тому числі правила орфографії і пунктуації; базові закономірності функціонування граматики англійської мови; основні лексичні і граматичні вимоги до викладання власних думок в письмовій і усній формі; граматичні правила, тенденції, виключення з правим, а також володіння певним запасом синонімічних знань.

вміти: використовувати весь діапазон лексико-граматичних засобів мови для використання думок з тем, які вивчаються та тренуються; здійснювати успішне виконання граматичних вправ, спираючись на опрацьований граматичний матеріал та володіти сталими навичками граматично правильно висловлювати думки у письмовій та усних формах.

Індивідуальну роботу доцільно проводити на усіх етапах навчального процесу під час вирішення різних дидактичних завдань: для засвоєння нових знань та його закріплення; формування та закріплення умінь та навичок; узагальнення та повторення пройденого; для контролю тощо. Найпростіше використовувати цю форму організації навчальної роботи при закріпленні, повторенні, організації різних вправ. Однак вона не менш ефективна і при самостійному вивченні нового матеріалу, особливо при його попередньому домашньому опрацюванні.

Індивідуальна та самостійна робота допомагає студенту покращити застосування граматичних структур за допомогою опрацювання суттєвої добірки вправ на часові форми, зокрема часові форми теперішнього часу, які широко використовуються в англійській мові. Під час індивідуальної та самостійної роботи студенти отримують якісні навички та знання, особливо на основі кропіткої практики, що сприяє професійному зростанню.

- Визначте розділи (теми або параграфи), у яких розкрито питання заняття.
- Прочитайте ці розділи.
- Складіть план відповіді на кожне питання.
- Визначте основні поняття, які Ви повинні засвоїти.
- Проаналізуйте, як опрацьований матеріал пов'язаний з іншими питаннями теми.
- Для кращого засвоєння та запам'ятовування матеріалу складіть короткий конспект, схеми, таблиці або графіки по прочитаному матеріалу.
- Визначте проблеми в опрацьованому матеріалі, які Ви недостатньо зрозуміли. З цими питаннями Ви можете звернутися на консультації до викладача.
- Перевірте, як Ви засвоїли опрацьоване питання. Ви можете це зробити, відповівши на тестові питання до теми або розв'язавши практичні завдання.

Конспектування автентичних підручників передбачає поглиблений розгляд окремих питань теми. Для конспектування можуть пропонуватися автентичні підручники британських та американських видань, які всебічно розглядають використання тієї чи іншої часової форми або іншої частини мови.

Алгоритм підготовки

- Прочитайте тему у запропонованому підручнику.
- Складіть план (простий або складний).
- Для кожного пункту плану виділіть основні положення проблеми, яка висвітлюється у підручнику.
- Представте прочитаний текст у вигляді тез або анотації, використовуючи, при потребі, схеми, таблиці, графіки тощо.
- Для самоперевірки перекажіть тему, використовуючи власний конспект.

- Оформіть реферат відповідно до вимог.
- Здайте реферат викладачу у зазначений термін.

Виконання індивідуальних завдань має на меті вироблення умінь, необхідних для практичного застосування навичок, отриманих впродовж вивчення теми.

Алгоритм виконання

- Ознайомтеся з вимогами до написання твору.
- Визначте, чи доводилося вам виконувати подібні завдання.
- Проаналізуйте теоретичний матеріал, необхідний для виконання індивідуального завдання.
- Визначте питання, на які ви не можете дати відповіді самостійно, та зверніться з ними на консультації до викладача.
- Конкретизуйте завдання, які ви маєте вирішити в ході виконання індивідуального завдання.
- Складіть розгорнутий план виконання завдання.
- Виконайте індивідуальне завдання відповідно до плану.
- Проаналізуйте, чи всі поставлені завдання ви виконали.
- Внесіть, при потребі, корективи до виконаного завдання.
- Оформіть завдання відповідно до вимог.
- Здайте завдання викладачу у зазначений термін.
