ВСТУП

Однією з найпопулярніших форм перевірки науково-педагогічними працівниками рівня засвоєних знань у сучасному закладі вищої освіти є тестування. В той час як традиційні усні та письмові завдання дозволяють виміряти глибину засвоєного матеріалу, то тестові завдання краще підходять для вимірювання широти та міцності знань. Тестовий контроль дає можливість охопити великий обсяг інформації, а також зафіксувати рівень стійкості знань у процесі її актуалізації в умовах відносного дефіциту часу і в нестандартних умовах.

- засвоїти певний обсяг соціокультурних знань за рахунок читання відповідних текстів, перегляду художніх фільмів, застосування ілюстративного матеріалу;
- навчити студентів вбачати в іноземній мові засіб одержання, розширення і поглиблення системних фахових знань, а також засіб самостійного підвищення своєї професійної кваліфікації.

Наведені у даному збірнику тестові завдання містять різні рівні складності та складаються з двох варіантів, кожен з яких містить чотири блоки завдань: завдання множинного вибору, завдання на встановлення відповідності, завдання на похідні та завдання з відкритою відповіддю.

Матеріал до тестових завдань було розроблено у відповідності з чинними навчальними програмами та побудовано за принципом програмованого контролю знань з теми, матеріал якої вивчається, що дозволяє перевірити, наскільки ґрунтовним є володіння змістом зазначеної навчальної дисципліни у здобувачів вищої освіти.
